keeping with Holy Cross charism of education, we shall avoid no sacrifice, and leave no stones unturned in providing holistic and quality educational opportunities to the young entrusted to our care, who hail from a wide range of backgrounds : social, intellectual, economic, ethnic and religious, who possess a wide range of talents and abilities. "We shall always place education side by side with instruction; the mind will not be cultivated at the expense of the heart". With zeal, we shall strive to form informed and useful citizens of the earthly society with heavenly values, and integrated morality. While striving to form excellent persons through our mission of education, we shall try "to blend gentleness with firmness, prudence and vigilance, which is the secret of successful education."

"EDUCATING HEART AND MIND"

In 1837 Bl. Basil Moreau, the Founder of the Congregation of Sainte Croix, (Holy Cross), envisioned education as the main source of empowering the young for a better and brighter world and to uplift the broken society of France. He prepared men and women religious, who wanted to see the world as he saw it, developed and empowered. To this end he founded a congregation of priests to do pastoral and educational ministry, Marianite sisters to do educational and domestic ministry and he incorporated the Brothers of St. Joseph to do formal and non-formal education. These three branches were brought under the one umbrella of Sainte Croix (Holy Cross). Thus Bl. Basil Moreau became a visionary who constantly spoke on the theme of unity as a family to keep the members focused on this meaningful mission of sowing the seed of **LOVE** and **PEACE**.

France : In 1789, the French Revolution, which rebelled against the political and religious oppression of the day, Stripped the country to the bare minimum and created destruction and chaos throughout France. It was a time of great confusion and division in the church, a period of uncertainty and fear, a time of execution and persecution, and a period *School Diary 2025-2026*

when the churches, schools and seminaries were all nationalized. Religious congregations and organizations were banned.

In 1802. Napoleon's Concordat made a breakthrough for the revival of the church organizations. There was a mushrooming of charismatic persons and organizations to answer to the needs of the devastated situation of the society. Education was one of the greatest needs of the time. The religious leaders focused all their resources on education and on restoring the fallen society.

One such religious leader was Basil Anthony Moreau, born on February 11, 1799, to Louis and Louis Moreau. He was the ninth of their fourteen children and showed a quick intelligence and qualities of leadership along with a pious character. He was ordained a priest on August 12, 1821, at the age of 22. Since the formation of the clergy was one of the urgent needs of the time, he was asked by his bishop to train and educate the youth of his time for the priesthood. Thus he become a professor at the philosophy house of the seminary in the Diocese of Le Mans, France.

Soon the international character of the community began to evolve. The Holy Cross priests, sisters and brothers established foundation in Algeria (1840), the United States (1842), Canada (1847), Chile, (1943), East Bengali (1853) and in India (1960).

Academic Year and Timings

The School academic year commences in April and ends in March.

School Working Days : Monday - Saturday Office Hours

The School office will remain open on all working days from 08.30am to 02.00pm (08.30am to 12.30pm on Saturday)

Rules for payment of School Fees

• Each Student will receive a school Fee booklet from the school office. Please note the only one school fee booklet will be given to an individual student. Any extra booklet will have to be bought from the school office.

•The school fees shall be paid in office fee counter

1. Fees will be received by the Office in-charge. The fee is to be paid on or before the 10^{th} of the following month failing which <u>a</u> <u>fine of Rs.10.00 per month</u> will be levied on all late payments. Please note that the fine will be cumulative. If for instance one's due is for the months of April and May and you pay the fees before 10^{th} of June, his/her fine for two months will be Rs.20/-

2. The School Fees cover twelve calendar months. No reduction is made for holidays or broken Periods.

3. Students who have not cleared the fee dues will not get the admit cards.

4. Fees will have to be paid as long as pupils name is on the roll.

5. The school fees and other dues are liable to be revised at any time due to the increasing cost of maintenance, other expenses and teachers' salary.

6. Certificates may be with held from pupils who have arrears of fees.

7.Pupils joining or leaving the school during the year will have to pay all the fees of that term. (April-September/October- March) 8. Parents/Guardians may pay all the fees at a time in the beginning of the year.

Academic Evaluations

Pre Mid-term : June to July Mid Term : October Post Mid-term : December Annual Exams : March



Promotion to higher class depends upon:

- a. Regularity in attendance (minimum 85% is a must)
- b. Quality of day-to-day participation in class.
- c. Written work and projects assigned by the subject teachers.
- d. Satisfactory performance at the internal assessments and tests. project must be submitted compulsary for promotion.
- e. The minimum mark required for pass for subjects out of 80 is 33 and for subjects out of 50 is 17.
- f. A pupil who fails to attain the required standard in language subjects (i.e. English, Bengali, and Hindi), Mathematics, Science, and Social Science will not be promoted.
- g. Promotion is granted on the basis of the marks/grades obtained in all the assessments/tests and whole year's work of the pupil. Hence, one needs to be regular in school.
- h. Students who do not appear for any of the Assessments will be treated as having no marks in it. The decision of the school authorities with regard to promotion is final.

INSTITUTION

- 1. Holy Cross School is a Catholic institution established and administered by the Holy Cross Educational Foundation. The institution comes under the Rights and Power granted to religious and linguistic minorities by the Constitution of India (Art.20 & 30)
- 2. The Institution is co-educational.
- 3. The medium of instruction is English while Bengali & Hindi is taught as second language.

AIM OF THE INSTITUTION

1. While, therefore, the prime purpose of the establishment of this Notre Dame Holy Cross High School, Moharpara is the education of the children in good character and principles. children of all faiths irrespective of caste, tribe, creed or community are accepted.

- 2. As Minority School, it is a learning community which has Christ as its central motivating force. His values as expressed in the beatitudes and summed up in the virtues, of love, sincerity, peace, justice and freedom will so permeate the atmosphere that children of all social backgrounds even the most deprived and of all religions feel welcomed in the loving warmth which cherishes even as it challenges.
- 3. This institution fosters child centered, activity based, value-focused educational system.

ATTENDANCE

- 1. 85% attendance is a must for every student for promotion. If the student is absent for more than three consecutive days, he/she should submit documents stating his/her reasons of absence to the Principal.
- 2. Regular attendance at school is in the interest of the student. It builds up a sense of devotion to duty and a habit for regularity and discipline.
- 3. The students should arrive on time to the school. Parents' cooperation will be much appreciated so that punctuality may be ensured.

WITH DRAWAL

- 1. In case a student has to be withdrawn, before the end of the academic year, prior to the withdrawal the fee of the term has to be cleared.
- 2. Should a pupil be removed from the school no certificate will be granted until all dues to the school have been paid.
- 3. Application for a Transfer certificate has to be made in writing to the Principal. This must be collected from the school office and Rs. 100/- is to be paid. Duplicate copies of Transfer Certificates are not issued.
- 4. Other Certificates will be issued against a written application and notice of three days must be given.

PARENTS AND GUARDIANS

- 1. Parents are requested to see that their children attend school punctually and to ensure that those who come to take children home are there at the time school closes.
- 2. Parents and Guardians are requested not to meet their children or interview a teacher during school hours without the permission of the Principal as the members of the staff may not leave the class room during a teaching period.
- 3. Parents are requested not to take their children for holidays before the set date for vacation nor to extend the vacation. No Leave of absence for the child will be granted without a previous written application from the guardian.
- 4. All correspondence regarding the students are to be addressed to the Principal.
- 5. Parents are requested to co-operate with the work of the school by enforcing regularity and discipline by taking a general interest in children's progress. Parents should check the school calendar everyday for any remarks, homework or holidays.
- 6. After every examination the guardians are requested to look into the performance of their students and put their signature on the progress report.
- 7. If any pupil is sick, parents are requested not to send the pupil to school.

Discipline

- 1. Pupils are expected to regularly prepare their lessons & do their home work. Those who have not done their home work will not be allowed to sit in the class.
- 2. It is obligatory to wear the uniform prescribed for the season on class days and at school functions. Those who are not correctly dressed in conformity with the regulation of the school will not be admitted to the class.
- 3. Except for reasons of ill-health and unavoidable circumstances, a previous written application from the guardians is required for any leave of absence. If any pupil has been absent for more than three days, he/she should not enter the class without first obtaining permission from the Principal.
- 4. Any pupil who absents himself/herself for one calendar month/ without a written permission from the Principal shall have his/her name struck off the rolls. To be-readmitted he/she will have to pay fresh admission fees as well as all fees for the said period of absence.
- 5. 85% attendance in a class is required for promotion to the next higher class. On medical grounds another 10% of attendance may be considered for promotion.
- 6. Those who do not report to class for one week after the vacations will have their names struck off the rolls. The principal reserves the right to consider applications for the re-admission of such pupils.
- 7. Pupils should treat their class rooms as sacred places. They a r e expected to maintain silence and order in the class rooms. Those who disturb the class will be sent out of the class room. During the absence of a teacher from the class, Pupils must obey the monitor appointed to maintain good order.
- 8. Running, playing or Shouting in the school building are not permitted. During the class hours pupils should move along the corridors in silence and in order.
- 9. Participation in games, physical training, cultural activities and socially useful productive works, are compulsory. Exemption will be granted on medical grounds only.

- 10. Books, cardigans, tiffin boxes, water bottles etc. belonging to the pupils should bear the name of the owner. It is advised to bring home cooked food only. The school does not hold itself responsible for articles lost in the school premises.
- 11. Pupils are not allowed to buy, sell or exchange any articles among themselves in the school premises.
- 12. No one should write on the furniture or walls or damage any school article. Damage by accident should be reported to the principal at once. Any damage caused to school property or the property of another student must be made good.
- 13. Pupils shall not circulate books, magazines or periodicals in the school without the permission of the principal.
- 14. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, theft, dishonesty, immoral conduct, insubordination, neglect of home work, disobedience or disrespect towards the members of the staff, unruly behaviour or immoral influence justify dismissal.
- 15. English should be spoken in the school and in the school premises at all times in order to acquire fluency in speaking the language.
- 16. Certificates will be issued only three days after the application has been submitted to the office. A fee of Rs. 50/- will be charged for any extract from the school registers.
- 17. Without the written permission from the Principal pupils will not be allowed to leave the school during school hours.
- 18. Pupils of this school are not permitted to bring Mobile Phones, Electronic gadgets, Fancy watches, Gold ornaments and other valuable goods to the school at any time.
- 19. Older children should set a good example to the younger children.
- 20. Usage of the bathrooms to be restricted only at the break time, unless it is an emergency and with permission.
- 21. All litters should be put in the dustbins before we say the final prayers daily.
- 22. Students must use only good, decent and positive words at all times.
- 23. Students must not waste electricity and water. Fans and Lights should be turned off before leaving the class room.

- 24. Students are to be quiet and orderly and observe proper decorum during school events such as assemblies, celebrations, and special occassions.
- 25. Students are to stand up and greet the teacher before and after every class. Pupil of one class is not allowed to go to another class.
- 26. Pants and skirts must be buttoned up properly and shirts be tucked in decently. Finger nails are to be short and unpainted and hair properly combed. Boys shirts should be half sleeve.
- 27. Male students must be neat in appearance with short hair. Girls must use hair accessories such as hair bands and clips, which are to be white. Girls hair should be neatly combed and made into two plaits. Ear ring & Piercing of nose is prohibited.
- 28. Tattoo is not allowed, chewing gum, gutka or any other addictive drugs bringing or using in the school promises or in the school bus can result in serious action.
- 29. Students are not allowed to post any indecent comments about the school, staff or students, or post photos in any form in any website.
- 30. Students are not to use jell on hair or colour their hair. Any student showing disrespect to the staff at any time will have to face serious consequences.
